



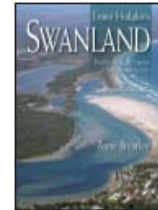

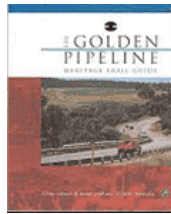

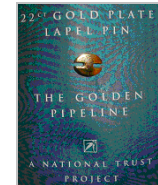


The Golden Pipeline Heritage Trail Guide

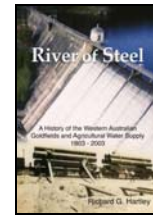
Golden Pipeline Cap

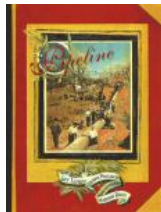
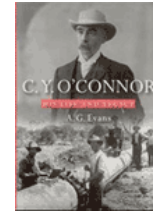


CY O'Connor: a brief biography by *Cyril Ayris*

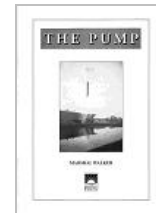


The Pipeline O'Connor Built by *J Lefroy and D Frylinck, illustrated by M Duke*
