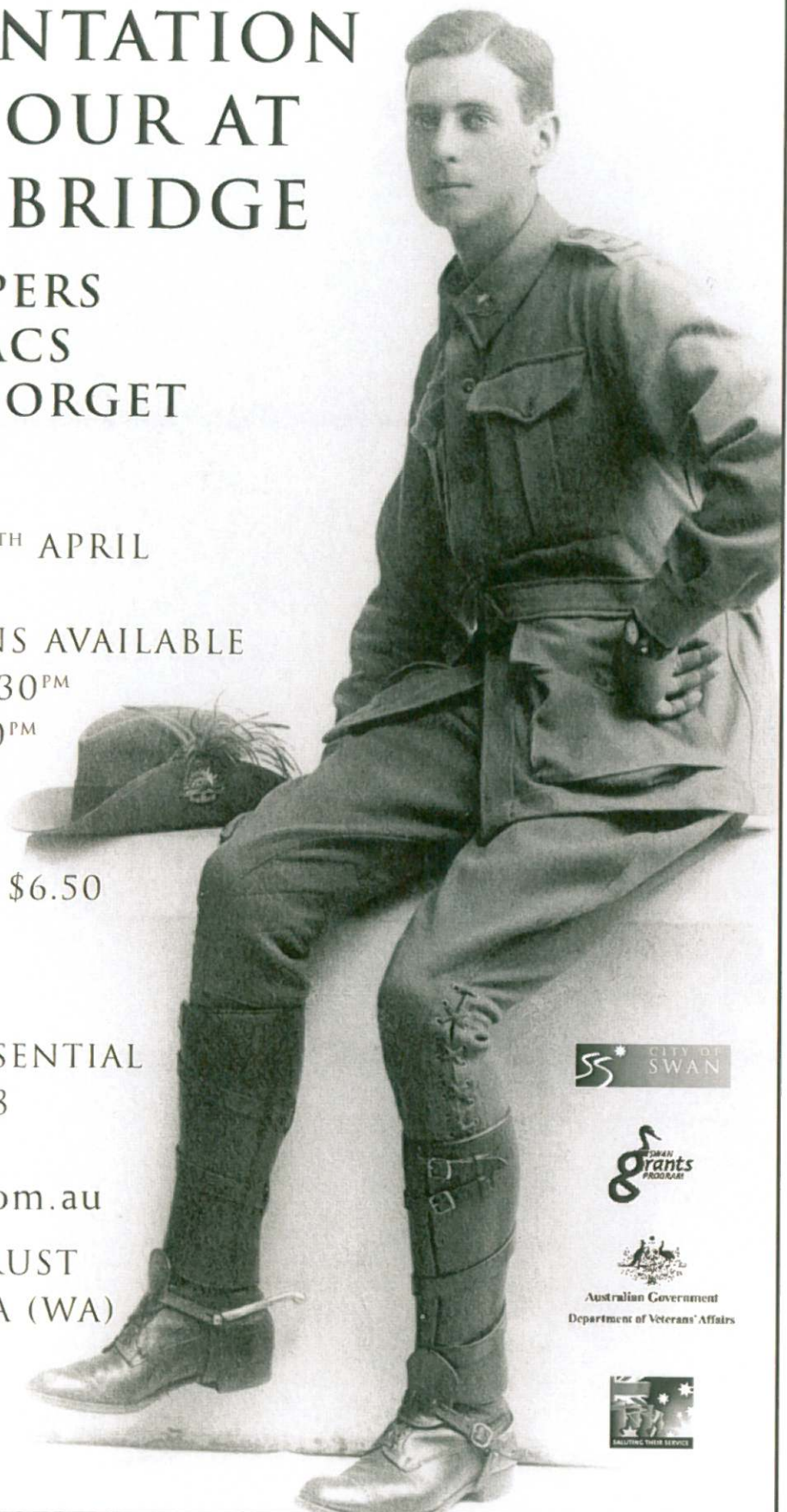

THE HARPERS THE ANZACS LEST WE FORGET

Following the highly acclaimed launch of *The Harpers: The ANZACS; Lest We Forget* in 2006, the National Trust of Australia (WA) once again presents this event on Anzac Day.

This National Trust initiative, funded by City of Swan, Department of Veterans' Affairs and the State Government unfolds the story of the Harper Family, the original owners of *Woodbridge*.

Two of the sons joined the 10th Light Horse Regiment and went to Gallipoli where they took part in the infamous charge at the Nek in August 1915. Wilfred, one of these Harper brothers, was the inspiration for Peter Weir's film *Gallipoli*. Their story is told through slides, photographs, the reading of letters, artefacts and memorabilia.
